

- 1) Ms. Vicki Carpenter, a representative of Keep Morehouse Beautiful, requested to be placed on the agenda *"to make* a Power Point presentation, 'A Good Story to Tell' highlighting the Magnet School. (Requested by Ms. Carpenter, presented by Ms. Carpenter)
- 2) To receive an update from Mr. Mark Brown concerning timber sales. (Requested by Dr. Noflin, presented by Mr. Mark Brown)
- 3) To receive a report from Mr. Jimmy Christmas regarding the properties which are most marketable for the district. (Requested by Dr. Noflin, presented by Mr. Christmas)

 - a. Section 16, Township 20 North, Range 7 East - 640 acres (hunting)
 - b. Section 16, Township 19 North, Range 8 East - 244 acres (hunting)
 - c. Section 16, Township 18 North, Range 6 East - 633 acres (hunting)
 - d. Section 16, Township 21 North, Range 7 East - 440 acres (hunting)
 - e. Section 33, Township 22 North, Range 6 East – 108 acres (hunting)
 - f. Section 16, Township 18 North, Range 10 East – 22.5 acres (agricultural)
