The Finance and Advisory Committee met on Tuesday, April 23, 2024 at 5:30 pm. **Robert Johnson-Chairperson (absent).** Debbie Wilson called the meeting to order in Robert Johnson – Chairperson's absence. Mr. Huntsman and Samantha Mann explained they will apply for a bond loan through the secretary of state, and he believes the amount has to be at least 5 million to be qualified for the loan. They are asking Morehouse Parish School Board to approve using the constitutional tax for this process. Morehouse Parish owns the property they are asking to renovate. If they don't follow through on the loan Morehouse Parish School Board still owns the property. There was much discussion on how the renovations were going to be funded. This was discussion only.
